## **Application Procedure**





Erasmus+/Exchange under general University of Warsaw bilateral agreements or visiting students should simply follow this procedure: FIERE

Exchange students under Faculty of Management bilateral agreements should submit the following documents:

- The application form will be sent to candidates or their coordinators by e-mail after receiving the nominations,
- Copy of student's passport picture page,
- 🔰 Curriculum Vitae,
- Official letter from home university confirming student's nomination,
- Previous education degree (e.g. copy of the diploma or Transcript of records) copy of student's passport picture page,
- A recent electronic photograph (to be sent via email). Student's photo must meet these requirements: at least 300x375 pixels, JPG format, max size 50 kB, same as in ID or passport. Detailed instruction on preparing correct photo will be sent as a separate attachment,
- English language ability (if it's not student's mother tongue): we accept the following certificates: GMAT, TOEFL, IELTS, CAE, CPE – B2 level minimum. Alternatively, we accept certificate from student's home university confirming English skills as above.

# Visas & Legalisation of stay in Poland

Before coming to Poland please make sure whether you have to apply for a Polish student visa in your country of origin.

### **Health Insurance**

Health insurance is **mandatory for all students** for the whole duration of their stay in Poland. Every student coming to the University of Warsaw for short-term studies will be asked to present proof of health insurance upon arrival.

We advise to purchase third party liability insurance and accident insurance in their home countries.

**EU citizens** staying in Poland are eligible for free health service providing they present their **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)** along with the **Student ID** and **passportor ID card**.

**EU citizens** not having insurance in their country of residence and non-EU citizens may sign an insurance agreement with **the Polish National Health Fund** (NFZ-Narodowy Fundusz Zdrowia) or with one of private clinics.

## **ID** Card

- works as a University library card.
- allows you to enter labs, computer rooms, etc.
- It also entitles students to a 50% discount on public transportation, including long-distance trains. It may be used as a carrier for 30-day city travel card and a 90-day city travel card.

**PLEASE NOTE:** students participating in the above programs receive their UW ID cards from the central UW International Relations Office (UW IRO) – not from the Faculty one!

- Exchange students under the Faculty of Management bilateral agreements should stay in touch with the Faculty International Section and do the following:
  - 1. Successfuly send your photo (see page 8)
  - 2. Pay the required fee (22 PLN ~6 USD, 5 EUR) by bank transfer:


