Maximum Exchange Period:

Minimum Application Requirements (GPA, Academic year/ semester, etc.)

1. **Minimum study level of incoming students:** it is indicated that the students were at least on their 2nd year of study at home university and have a basic knowledge of the provided by the UW courses' areas such as Management, Marketing, Finance, Economics, etc.

2. GPA: not specified but the higher the better

3. The UW accepts various range of certificates confirming the knowledge of a foreign language at **minimum B2 level** according to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: learning, teaching, assessment (CEFR):

Language of instruction:	All courses offered to our exchange students are conducted in English.

Tuition and fees

Tuition:	In accordance with the Student Exchange Agreements between the Faculty of Management, UW and the partner universities tuition fees at the UW for incoming Exchange Students will be waived.
Accommodation:	All costs related to accommodation will be borne by students themselves. Relevant housing information will be forwarded to students by our Faculty IRO after receiving nominations from partner universities. Mandatory Health/ Accident Insurance Information:	<p>Health/ accident insurance is mandatory for all students for the whole duration of their stay in Poland. Otherwise you will be asked to pay for any health service you get. Every student coming to the University of Warsaw for short-term studies will be asked to present proof of health insurance upon arrival.</p> <p>Foreign students and academics are advised to purchase third party liability insurance and accident insurance in their home countries.</p> <p>EU citizens staying in Poland are eligible for free health service providing they present their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) along with the Student ID and passport or ID card.</p>

**Mandatory Health/
Accident Insurance

EU citizens not having insurance in their country of residence and non-EU citizens may sign an insurance agreement with the Polish National Health Fund (NFZ-Narodowy Fundusz Zdrowia) or with one of private clinics.
