



GUIDE FOR CANDIDATES FOR EXECUTIVE MBA STUDIES 2026 – 2028

Our Executive MBA program was established in 1991 in cooperation with leading American Universities and was the first international MBA program in Poland. Almost 1,500 people have completed our program.

Our graduates are members of the boards of the largest companies in Poland, Europe, and the world. The Alumni Association is actively supporting the networking and social activities for our graduates.

Each year, our Program occupies leading positions in national and international MBA rankings, including Perspektywy and Eduniversal.

For many years, our programs have had the most prestigious accreditations in the world: AMBA (Association of MBAs), AACSB, BGA and EQUIS.




HOW TO APPLY

- Each person applying for our EMBA@UW Studies must complete the recruitment process for post-graduate studies at the University of Warsaw, meeting the conditions set by Polish law and accrediting institutions: Association of MBAs and EQUIS.
- After passing the recruitment process, the examination committee decides to admit the candidate to postgraduate studies. Each of the applicants will be notified in writing about the result of the application procedure.

REQUIREMENTS

Conditions for taking the entrance examination:

1. Registration in the IRK (Internet Registration of Candidates of the University of Warsaw), and then enrollment in IRK for our studies on the websites with the following addresses:

2. Having at least five years of professional experience, including at least three years in a managerial position. Information about the experience should be included in the application questionnaire in the dedicated sections.
3. Delivery of a complete set of application documents **by June 29, 2026** (IRK registration).

**The entrance examination
will be held ONLINE
on from 3 – 4 July, 2026**

Together with the documents, application fee in the IRK system should be paid
– **85 PLN (by June 30, 2026).**

List of required documents for registration in the IRK System:

1. Application for admission to studies
2. EMBA@UW personal questionnaire
3. Bachelor's or Master's degree diploma
4. Two letters of recommendation (preferred: from the current or previous employer/supervisor, contractor or associate). If the recommending persons wish to maintain confidentiality, the signed letters can be sent to the secretariat of studies: mba@uw.edu.pl

After receiving a positive admission decision, the required documents must be submitted in paper form to the Executive MBA Office.

ENTRY EXAMS

They consist of:

- 60-minute math and logic test (in English for English-language studies).
- 60-minute English language test (the exempt from this part of the exam are: native English speakers, English philology graduates, and university graduates from an English-speaking country or having knowledge of this language at B2 level documented by an FCE, TOEFL, IELTS certificate or a state exam).
- 20-minute interview regarding the candidate's professional experience and his motivation to undertake MBA studies (3–4 July, 2026).

Written exams last approximately 2 hours in total. Interviews are generally held on Saturday after the exam, based on individual arrangements. The candidates will be informed about the examination procedure during the recruitment process.

Tuition fee include:

- The cost of classes and teaching materials for classes, available in online, pdf, or printed versions, depending on the copyright held.
- In English-language studies also the cost of the necessary textbooks in paper or electronic version.
- Online and traditional access to the Libraries of the University of Warsaw, including databases, scientific and popular science journals such as Harvard Business Review or The Economist.
- Costs related to the issuance of the Program Completion Certificate.
- Integration session costs.

Students can participate in additionally paid trips abroad, during which classes and study meetings are conducted in English. There are three possibilities for a study trip:

- To Cambridge, UK (The cost is included in the tuition fees)
- To Mumbai, India (Tentative cost: USD 3.000)
- To New York or Chicago, USA (Cost: USD 3.000)

The study trips will take place only if the minimum required number of participants sign in. Departures are subject to an additional agreement.
